GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

BYLAW NO. 2022-04

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Maple Creek No. 111, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows;

- 1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Maple Creek No. 111
- 3. Section 5 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 4. No person shall provide a false or misleading statement to any Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Designated Officer, Peace Officer or person appointed to enforce any Bylaw of the Municipality.
- 5. Every Person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - a. In the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which to offence continues; and
 - b. In the case of a corporation, to fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
- 6. Bylaw No, 08-2020 is hereby repealed.
- 7. This Bylaw has been read a third time and shall come into force and take effect on June 8, 2022.
