RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MAPLE CREEK NO. 111

BYLAW NO 2016 - 8

A BYLAW TO EXTEND THE TIME REQUIRED FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Maple Creek No. 111 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

The time required for completion of certain financial and audit procedures for the 2015 Financial Statement be extended as follows:

- (a) The time required pursuant to subsection 185(1) of *The Municipalities Act* to complete the annual audit of the municipality's books and records of the annual financial statement be and is extended to (specify date no later than September 13, 2016.
- (b) The time required pursuant to subsection 186(1) of *The Municipalities Act* for the submission of a copy of the financial statement and the auditor's report be and is extended to September 29, 2016
- (c) The time required pursuant to subsection 185(3) of *The Municipalities Act* to publicize the financial statement or synopsis and auditor's report be and is extended to November 30, 2016..

(A bylaw passed must be passed within 30 days after the time fixed pursuant to this Act has expired. No council shall pass a bylaw extending the time fixed by this ACT by more than 90 days)
