GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

BYLAW NO. 2022-04

**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF
BYLAWS**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Maple Creek No. 111, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows;

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the “General Penalty Bylaw”.
2. “Municipality” means the Rural Municipality of Maple Creek No. 111
3. Section 5 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
4. No person shall provide a false or misleading statement to any Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Designated Officer, Peace Officer or person appointed to enforce any Bylaw of the Municipality.
5. Every Person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - a. In the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which to offence continues; and
 - b. In the case of a corporation, to fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
6. Bylaw No, 08-2020 is hereby repealed.
7. This Bylaw has been read a third time and shall come into force and take effect on June 8, 2022.
